Australia's most experienced English college

Established in 1984 and successor to Victoria School of English, founded in 1971, Milner is Australia's oldest independent English college.

The former director, Warren Milner, is an honours graduate of the University of Western Australia with postgraduate qualifications in education. Rosemary Milner has an honours degree in languages and is postgraduate of the University of London. Director, Matthew Milner is a law graduate and Cambridge qualified teacher.

The directors are fully involved in the day to day running of the college, which is totally owned by the Milner family.

On average, 30 countries are represented at Milner College. About half the students come from Asia and the rest from Europe and Latin America. Usually no nationality exceeds 20%.

- Free use of **Perth City library**.






The Teachers

All the staff at Milner College are experienced professionals with university or college degrees and the **University of Cambridge CELTA qualification.**

They have been selected for their ability to engage with young adults. Most have had experience teaching English overseas and between them speak a variety of languages.



Method

The courses have been devised to satisfy the requirements of people who need English for a better job or business or who need to gain admission to a university or college. Others simply want to enjoy the experience of living and learning in an English speaking country.

The courses are intensive and practical, with a focus on real life situations. Teaching is a blend of techniques based on our long experience and the latest methodology. Our teachers' resource centre is full of authentic material to support our learner centred, activity based approach.

Grading

After enrolling at the college, each student's English is assessed by means of both written and spoken test. He or she is then placed in a class at one of the eight levels from Beginners to Advanced. The college accepts students at any level of English. The minimum age is 16 years.

The progress of each student is monitored by his or her teacher and the Director of Studies. If it is thought a student would benefit, transfer to another level is made immediately.



PET courses three times a year. **Virtual PET** starting in **June**.

I.E.L.T.S. courses run continuously throughout the year.



Students receive a certificate at the end of their course stating level of achievement and period of attendance.



Orientation

This happens at 15:15 on your first day, when you will be shown the college's facilities and given help in such things as opening a bank account, getting a Smartrider form to get student fares in public transport, discounted gym membership and so on.

Pathways

Milner's Pathway agreements enable students to transition easily to the course of their choice.

Entry to universities like Curtin, Murdoch and ECU, is through our Cambridge Advanced course or our Cambridge Proficiency course, or our IELTS Preparation course. Meanwhile for vocational colleges, including TAFE, you need to complete our Upper Intermediate level of English, accompanied by an Academic Report.

TESOL

This course is for students who wish to teach English to children and teenagers in their own country. An intermediate level of English is required. Graduates receive the Milner TESOL Certificate.




Teacher Training
